Aprobado milagro que permitirá su canonización Después de meses de espera, el milagro que permitirá la canonización de la Beata Madre Teresa de Calcuta fue oficialmente aprobado por el Vaticano. La querida religiosa será declarada santa y solo se aguarda la fecha de la ceremonia. Los rumores sobre la canonización circulan desde hace meses. Sin embargo, el Vaticano hizo el anuncio oficial en un comunicado, junto con el reconocimiento de las virtudes heroicas del Padre Giuseppe Ambrosoli de los Misioneros Combonianos del Corazón de Jesús, dándole el título de Venerable.
BEATA MADRE TERESA DE CALCUTA
Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu nació en 1910 en Skopje, entonces Albania y actual Macedonia. Murió el 5 de septiembre de 1997 en su amada Calcuta, India. Cuando se hizo religiosa tomó el nombre de Teresa. Es la fundadora de las Misioneras de la Caridad. Decía de sí misma: "De sangre soy albanesa. De ciudadanía, India. En lo referente a la fe, soy una monja Católica. Por mi vocación, pertenezco al mundo. En lo que se refiere a mi corazón, pertenezco totalmente al Corazón de Jesús".
