'THE AGE OF MERCY'

In the months following his election, Pope Francis became
convinced the conversion of the world needs to come, at this
time, through mercy. In his first airborne press conference, he
noted how clergy sex abuse, corruption and clericalism had
hurt so many, and said: "The Church is a mother: she has
to go out to heal those who are hurting, with mercy ...
She must travel this path of mercy. And find a form of mercy
for all." Citing the Father's embrace of the prodigal son as the
model for the Church, Pope Francis said: "I believe that this is
a kairos: this time is a kairos of mercy." In an Angelus this
January, he again observed: "We are living in the age of
mercy, this is the age of mercy." A kairos is a time of special
favor, an opportune time for God to be grasped in the present.
It is an idea he has captured in his declaration of a Holy Year
dedicated to the theme of mercy that will run from Dec. 8, the
feast of the Immaculate Conception, which is also this year the
50th anniversary of the closing of the Second Vatican Council,
through the feast of Christ the King on Nov. 20, 2016.

YEAR OF MERCY:

The Church teaches that there are seven corporal (of the body)
and seven spiritual works of mercy. This Easter season, put
one work of mercy into practice each week.

Lenten Examination of Conscience

The Corporal Works of Mercy: Do I...

- ◆ feed the hungry and give drink to the thirsty
 - ◆ give shelter to the homeless
 - ◆ give clothing to the naked
- ◆ visit the sick and those in nursing homes
 - ◆ visit the imprisoned
- ◆ give a proper Catholic Funeral to loved ones

Week One: Feed the hungry.

Buy gift cards or meals for people standing at street corners.

Make a meal and deliver it to a neighbor less needy.

Volunteer at a food pantry, food bank, or soup kitchen.

Send a donation to Catholic Charities or other
worthy organizations you may know.
