YOUTH EVANGELIZATION - \$10 million

The children and young adults of today are blessed with many
advantages their predecessors never imagined. They have
access to technology and social media, making the world
smaller and more accessible. With all the benefits of these new
technological and cultural advancements, come the side
effects of distraction and alienation. These and other factors
produce barriers to their faith journey. Lately we have
witnessed more and more young Catholics cut or minimize
ties to the church community. In response to these challenges,
and the request of many parish communities in Brooklyn and
Queens, the Catholic Foundation funded the launch of the
Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative. The initiative is focused on
uniting our youth with the local Catholic community, so that
they too can appreciate the joy of our faith, and empowering
them to live as disciples of Jesus Christ in our world today by
participating in the life, mission and work of the Church.

Through a comprehensive youth ministry approach that has
proven successful in other Dioceses, the initiative provides on-
site support to parishes through funding salaries of youth min-
isters, and grants for ongoing resources and professional de-
velopment. With an additional investment of
\$10 million over the next five years, the program can
expand to parishes across the Diocese by 2020
