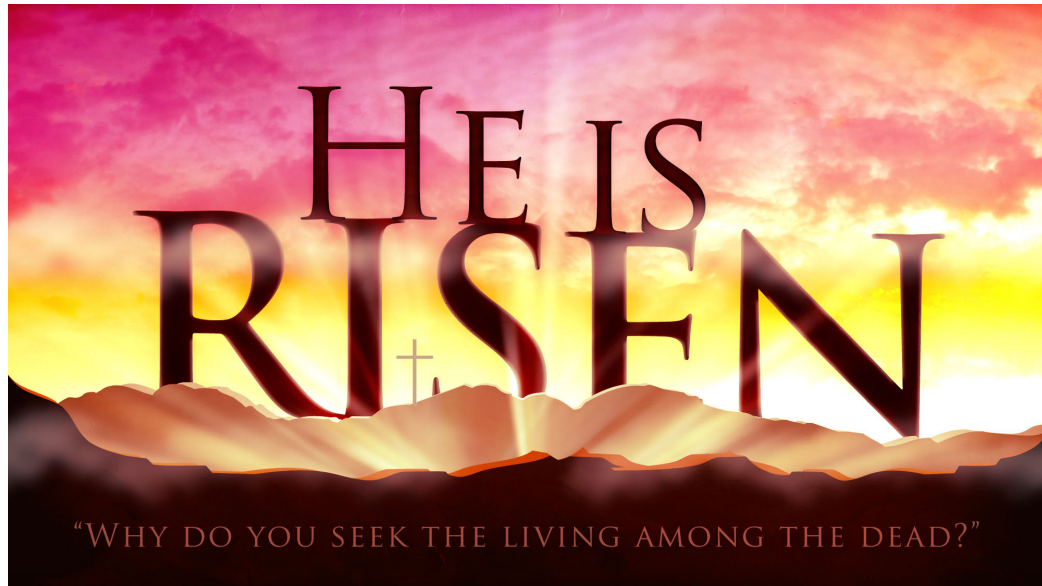

Easter Sunday of The Resurrection of The Lord:

Easter is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead.

It is celebrated on Sunday, and marks the end of Holy Week, the end of Lent, the last day of the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday), and is the beginning of the Easter season of the liturgical year. As we know from the Gospels, Jesus Christ rose from the dead on the third day following his crucifixion, which would be Sunday. His resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. It is the singular event which proves that those who trust in God and accept Christ will be raised from the dead. Since Easter represents the fulfillment of God's promises to mankind, it is the most important holiday on the Christian calendar. In the Gospels, the precise details of the Easter narrative vary slightly, but none of these variances are critical to the main story. In fact, it is argued that the variances are simply matters of style and not substance. Despite the variances, the key aspects of the Easter story all match. Above all, they agree that the tomb of Christ was indeed empty, which is the most essential fact. Based on direct evidence from the mid-second century, it is believed that Easter was regularly celebrated from the earliest days of the Church. The Easter date is movable and always falls on a Sunday between March 22 and April 25. Easter in the Roman Catholic Church is always on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the spring equinox. Following Easter Sunday, the season of Easter begins and lasts for seven weeks, ending with Pentecost.

EN ESPANOL

Domingo de Resurrección

es la fiesta central del cristianismo, en la que se conmemora, de acuerdo con los evangelios canónicos, la resurrección de Jesús al tercer día después de haber sido crucificado. La Pascua marca el final de la Semana Santa, en la que se conmemora la crucifixión y muerte de Jesús. A la Semana Santa le sigue un período de cincuenta días llamado Tiempo pascual, que termina con el Domingo de Pentecostés. El Domingo de Pascua es una fiesta móvil, lo que significa que no se fija en relación al calendario civil. El Primer Concilio de Nicea (año 325) estableció la fecha de la Pascua como el primer domingo después de la luna llena tras el equinoccio de primavera en el hemisferio norte. La fecha por tanto, varía entre el 22 de marzo y el 25 de abril. El cristianismo oriental basa sus cálculos en el calendario juliano, por lo que su fecha se sitúa entre el 4 de abril y 8 de mayo. Durante este día se celebran en distintos lugares del mundo procesiones religiosas, así como celebraciones litúrgicas. Las costumbres del Domingo de Resurrección varían en todo el mundo cristiano, pero la decoración de los huevos de Pascua es algo común en muchos países del mundo occidental.¹
