Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday
after Easter, the Octave of Easter, observed by Roman
Catholic as well as some Anglicans. It is originally based on
the Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy that Saint Faustina
Kowalska reported as part of her encounter with Jesus, and is
associated with special promises from Jesus and
indulgences issued by the Church. The feast of Divine Mercy,
as recorded in the diary of Saint Faustina, receives from Jesus
himself the biggest promises of grace related to the Devotion
of Divine Mercy. In specific, Jesus reputedly said that a
person who goes to sacramental confession (the confession
may take place some days before) and receives Holy
Communion on that day, shall obtain the total forgiveness of
all sins and punishment. That means each person would go
immediately after death to heaven without suffering
in purgatory (orhell). Additionally, the Roman Catholic
Church grants a plenary indulgence (observing the usual rules)
with the recitation of some simple prayers.

Domingo de la Misericordia se celebra el domingo después de
Pascua. Se basa originalmente en la devoción católica a la
Misericordia Divina que Santa Faustina Kowalska informó como
parte de su encuentro con Jesús, y se asocia con promesas especiales
de Jesús e indulgencias emitidos por la Iglesia. La fiesta de la Divina
Misericordia, según consta en el Diario de Santa Faustina, recibe de
sí mismo los más grandes promesas de gracia relacionados con la
devoción de la Divina Misericordia de Jesús. En concreto, según se
dice Jesús dijo que una persona que va a la confesión sacramental
(la confesión puede pasar algunos días antes) y recibe la sagrada
comunión en ese día, obtendrá el perdón total de todos los pecados y
el castigo. Esto significa que cada persona podría ir inmediatamente
después de la muerte al cielo sin sufrir en el purgatorio . Además, la
Iglesia Católica concede una indulgencia plenaria (respetando las
reglas habituales) con la recitación de algunas oraciones simples.
