CONFIRMATION.. We will see 7 of our young people confirmed
in our faith and called to action as disciples of the Lord. Confirmation
enriches these baptized youth with the strength of the Holy Spirit to
better witness to Christ in word and deed. This is a good time for all
of us to recall our own Confirmation and our call to continue to
respond to the Holy Spirit. At Confirmation our faith and
membership in the Body of Christ is strengthened. We are connected
to the large community of the Church, which is global. We receive
the gifts of the Holy Spirit – diverse spiritual gifts to build up the
Church, to care for others and the needs of the world. The Spirit
given moves us (throughout life) to imitate the love and service of
Christ. The Spirit pours love into our hearts that we become
instruments of God's grace to others. We commit to participate in
the Church's work and mission – strengthened for ongoing service in
the Body of Christ, bearing witness to our faith in words
accompanied by deeds. We are commissioned (anointed) to live out
our faith in the world. Let us remember that Confirmation calls us to
share Christ's mission to promote life, dignity and universal justice.
We share Christ's priestly mission, giving of ourselves as did Christ
on the cross. As prophets we announce the Kingdom of God,
witnessing to the Gospel in family, social life and community. We
share His Kingly mission by overcoming the kingdom of sin, giving
of ourselves, recognizing Jesus in the least ones and working for
justice and peace. All who are anointed by the Holy Spirit share
Christ's mission as found in Luke's Gospel: "The Spirit of the Lord is
upon me, He has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He
has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to
the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year
acceptable to the Lord! May God bless our Confirmation Candidates
with worthy lives as disciples of the Lord.
