Generations of Faith:

We have officially joined with the rest of the diocese in the "Generations of Faith" campaign to raise \$80 million. Bishop DiMarzio would like to raise \$30 million to help take care of those priests who have given their lives in service and who are now senior, retired and some of them sickly. He would like to raise an additional \$10 million for ministry to our youth- the future of the church. The additional \$40 million will come back to the parishes to take care of delayed maintenance in the churches. Our goal is \$500,000.00 and thanks to a handful of our members, we have already received pledges in the amount of \$298,586.00. Everyone will be asked to be generous and sacrifice for this worthy cause. Our Deacon Leroy thinks we can raise 1 million for St. Paul & St. Agnes.
