*2016-2017 Budget Approved:*

The Bishop has approved our budget for this fiscal year beginning Sept. 1st. We will need \$ 11,500.00 a week to break even at the end of this fiscal year. Are you honestly tithing 10% of your gross income on a regular basis?

*Sunday School:*

To be more realistic financially running our religious education program, we had to raise the fees this year. We are also asking the parents to realistically sit down with your children and help them to figure out what 10% of their allowance is each week and then to take that and put it in the tithing envelope which they will put in the Sunday collection. All of the tithes which the children pay goes directly towards the expenses of Sunday school. After a long break it will be good to see all of the children again at mass and in Sunday school as they continue to learn about Jesus and what He expects from all of us.
