Solemnity of the
Epiphany.*

"The Lord and ruler is coming; kingship is his, and government and power." With these words the Church proclaims that today's feast is the high point of Christmas and the fulfillment of Advent. The young Messiah is revealed as the light of the nations. Epiphany means manifestation, the manifestation of our Lord to the whole world; after being made known to the shepherds of Bethlehem He is revealed to the Magi who have come from the East to adore Him. The mystery of the Epiphany brings upon us three manifestations of Jesus' glory: the mystery of the Magi coming from the East, under the guidance of a star, and adoring the Infant of Bethlehem as the divine King; the mystery of the Baptism of Christ, who, whilst standing in the waters of the Jordan, was proclaimed by the Eternal Father as Son of God; and thirdly, the mystery of the divine power of this same Jesus, when he changed the water into wine at the marriage feast of Cana.
