Annual Catholic Appeal:

The 42 members have paid \$ 19,680.00 on their pledges. **Thank you for your support of our Bishop and all the good he does in our diocese!**

Generations of Faith:

You pledged \$ 772,746.00 and have paid \$ 148,951.62 in response to our Bishop's plea for help in the diocese and in the churches. These pledges are payable over a 5 year period. Unfortunately, we have been informed that too many of the pledges are "delinquent". When you receive the reminder in the mail of what payment you agreed to in your pledge, please try to make good on what you agreed upon. Again, as we look forward to work on both St Paul's and St Agnes, the extra revenue will certainly come in handy.

When we think of a journey, we normally think of some kind of movement from point A to point B. The Christian journey, begun in the waters of baptism (point A) has as its ultimate destination eternal life with God in heaven (point B).
