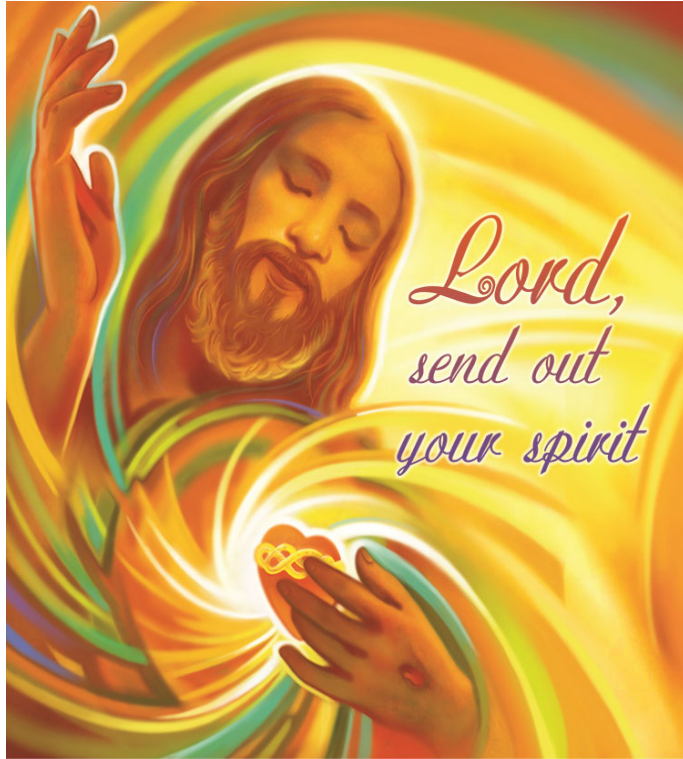

Congratulations:

We are going to put another ad in the June 4th edition of the Tablet congratulating Father Willy Kingsley Ndi on his ordination as priest. The ad costs \$ 306.00. Again, if you would like to help pay for it, please put your gift in an envelope with the words "Tablet Ad" and place it in the collection basket. If we go over, we will give Father Willy an ordination gift.

Annual Catholic Appeal:

To date, 48 of our close to 400 members have pledged a total of \$ 28,740.00 towards our parish goal of \$ 37,851.00. We are short of our goal by \$ 9,191.00. If you have already made a pledge, **Thank you.** If you are one of the 352 members who have not as yet made a pledge, we ask that you try to do something so we can reach our goal and if we go over, the overage comes right back to St Paul and St Agnes. Extra pledge envelopes are at the entrance.

Generations of Faith:

You pledged \$ 772,886.00 and have paid \$ 171,472.39 in response to our Bishop's plea for help in the diocese and in the churches. These pledges are payable over a 5 year period. Unfortunately, we have been informed that too many of the pledges are "delinquent". When you receive the reminder in the mail of what payment you agreed to in your pledge, please try to make good on what you agreed upon. Again, as we look forward to work on both St Paul's and St Agnes, the extra revenue will certainly come in handy.

Action in The Spirit

When our world has been turned upside down, when we are faced with uncertainties about what is real, when we are unsure about what lies ahead for us, when we don't know what we should do next, we do not want to be alone. Neither did the apostles and all those who loved Jesus. They wanted to be together when they needed to make sense of what was happening to them and what was going to be asked of them.
