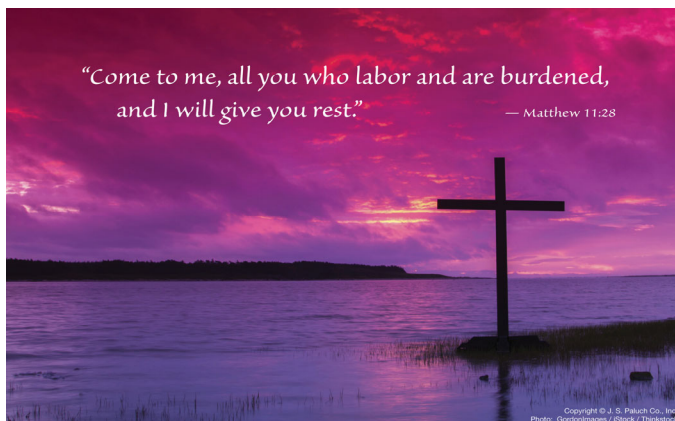

Come to Me..

Some of the most comforting words in the Gospels appear in today's reading. "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will

give you rest . . . For my yoke is easy and my burden light"

(Matthew 11: 28, 30). Sometimes we carry what seem to be

impossible burdens; we carry our cross. But we might be carrying the

wrong cross. Our cross, we are promised, will be easy and our burden

light. This might not seem to be true when we suffer the loss of a loved

one, a job, our home, or our livelihood. But if we turn to Jesus, we will

always find the comfort and loving kindness of the Father, the Son,

and the Holy Spirit. The children look to us adults for comfort and

support, for "although you have hidden these things from the wise and

the learned you have revealed them to little ones" (Matthew 11:25).

We can learn from children about our dependence on God. So Jesus

says to us, "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek

and humble of heart" (Matthew 11:29). Again, the Lord's humility

reveals neither bragging nor false denial of his power, but an

acknowledgement of his love for us.

Annual Catholic Appeal:

To date, 58 of our 400 member have pledged a total of \$ 31,345.00 towards our goal of \$ 37,851.00. If you are one of the 342 members who have not as yet made a pledge, please consider doing something so that we can reach our goal and not have to make up the difference from our operating fund. Extra pledge envelopes are at the entrance of both churches.

Hotel Discount:

The Holiday Inn located at 300 Schermerhorn Street here in Brooklyn offers you and your visitors a discount if you tell them you are members of St Paul and St Agnes Parish. This will be convenient for the wedding parties at St Agnes.

What Does It Cost?:

People wonder how much does it cost to have a Priest assigned to a parish. We now have 2 priests officially assigned to St Paul and St Agnes parish. The total cost for the year including benefits, medical, insurance, support, pension, travel, food, diocesan obligations, etc comes to \$ **131,825.00**. This breaks down to each of the 400 members of the parish responsible for an extra \$ 6.35 a month in your envelope. Not bad for all the services provided each month. Who else could you get away with paying \$ 6.35 a month - **WAY BELOW THE MINIMUM WAGE!!!!**

A Buck = One Dollar = \$ 1.00:

Unfortunately, many of you are putting one dollar a week in the collection basket. One dollar does not get you a ride on the bus or train, even with the senior citizen reduced rate card; one dollar does not get you a piece of pizza or a hot dog. One dollar does not help us pay the lighting bills, heat bills, air conditioner bills. Look at the expenses each week in the bulletin. Are you paying your fair share? Remember, we are self-supporting. The government nor the diocese give us any financial help. The bible tell us to give 10% of our gross income to the support of the church on a regular basis. Are you living up to the biblical imperative?
