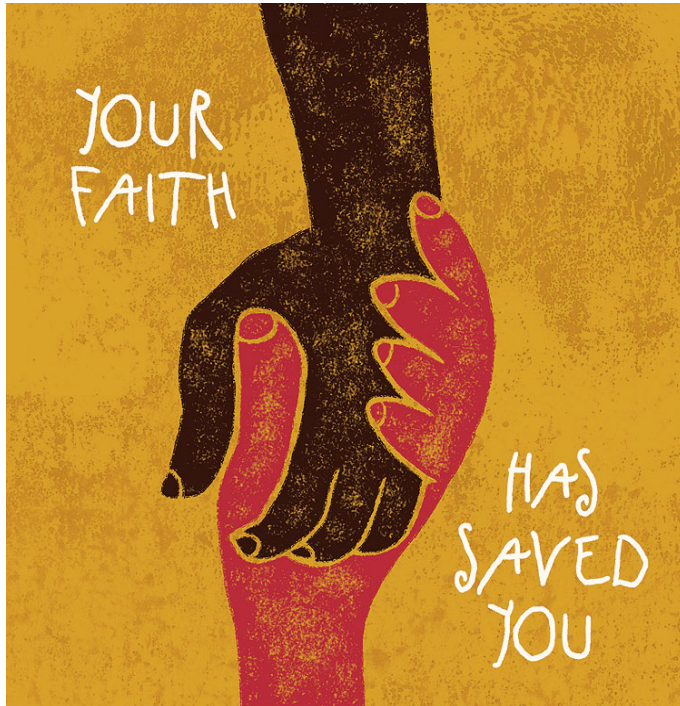

When we lose a loved one, we can wonder why the presence of Christ is not enough to make that person rise, even from death, as did the little girl in today's Gospel passage. Let us pray that our mourning will one day be turned into dancing.**
