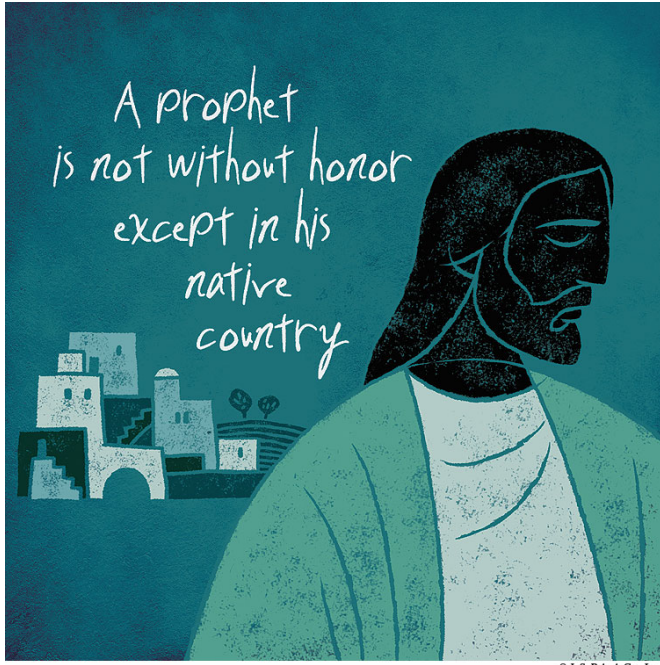

Marist Missions Around The World

Since its official recognition by the church in 1838, the society of Mary (Marist Fathers and Brothers) has committed itself to the missions in the southwest Pacific. Since that time, the Marists have expanded into areas in Africa, Asia and South America. Today there are nearly 230 priests and brothers working in "bush stations", teaching in schools and seminaries, ministering in training institutions, proving direct service to the poor, oppressed and marginalized, and contributing to the development of people for a better society and a strong local church. Contributions to the Marists will help them in their mission of witness to the Gospel, service to the needy and helping the local church to build a strong base for it's promising future. They will visit us next weekend July 14-15. Thank you for whatever you can do to help them in their life-long commitment and work.
