The first reading is about wisdom. It is a love poem written
 to the object of the author's desire. The author loves wisdom
 itself and experiences wisdom as the source of all good
 things, all riches. The psalm tells us that wisdom is
 kindness. It is knowing and doing the work of God. It is
 understanding what our life is for. Hebrews recognizes that
 Wisdom is, in fact, the Word of God, Jesus. The source of
 our continuing life is Jesus. Mark makes this even more
 personal with the story of one man. A good man who has
 observed the laws from his youth, even in the loving presence
 of Jesus, cannot find the strength to leave his worldly
 possession behind and follow.
